Nail Tips By Rhaina!

Lining the lips.

Outline the lips carefully, rounding the bow of the upper lip and then tracing inwards in short strokes. Start the lower lip in the centre and trace along your own lipline towards the outside. Remember to fill in the entire mouth with the pencil. Apply your lip colour with a brush and fill the entire mouth up to the same edge as the lip pencil. Powder, blot and re-apply. If you choose to reshape the mouth, first cover the natural lip line with concealer. This gives the finished shape a more realistic look.

Lipstick bleeding into the fine lines around the lips.

Cornstarch absorbs more for its weight in water and oil than other powders. By dusting just a small amount of baby cornstarch over the mouth area you can reduce the chance of lipliners or lipstick bleeding into the fine lines around the lips.
